In April, we selected eight of the twenty 2010-2011 SC Junior Book Award Nominees for NCMS's summer reading list. Then, we introduced the books to the students and offered each rising 6th, 7th, and 8th grader the opportunity to choose a book to read over summer vacation. We purchased the books and gave each student the book he or she chose.

Requirements:

- All students at NCMS are only required to read the ONE FREE BOOK given to them by Dr. Richardson.
- If students would like to read additional books from our summer reading list, there will be additional rewards in the fall. The more you read, the more rewards you will receive!
- If parents would like for their child to read a book other than the one he or she chose, that is fine. In that case, parents may simply take the summer reading list to the public library to borrow a copy, or copies may be purchased. The school will not be able to switch out or give additional books to students.

In August: We will have a day set aside with special activities to be announced for the purpose of celebrating and sharing our novels with each other. Lots of fun guaranteed! **Students: Be sure to read your book.** We want everyone to be able to join the fun! Don't miss out on the celebration!

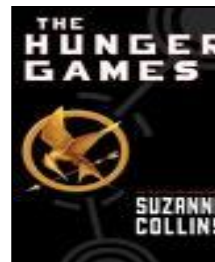

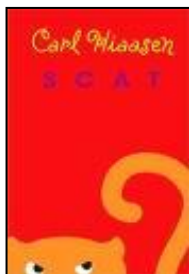

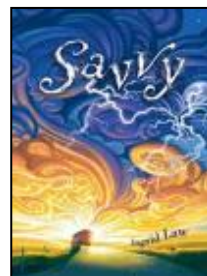
